Introduction



The success of the first Malaysia-Africa Palm Oil Trade Fair and Seminar (MA-POTS) held in conjunction with the continent's largest food and beverage event – Africa's Big Seven – has encouraged a follow up meeting in the West Africa Region, which is an emerging agriculture investment destination. Generally, it is viewed that the demand for oils and fats will continue to grow in this region and Malaysian palm oil exports to this region are projected to exceed one million metric tonnes for the first time in 2011. 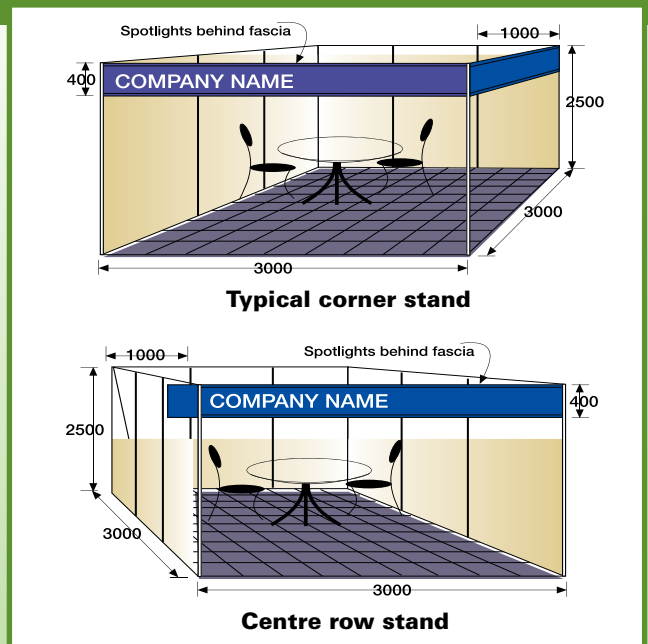
